



As a community organization and a communal space, we understand the vital importance of public health and protecting our visitors. The safety and health are of great concern to us and as such MAM staff have enacted the following changes to operations during the coronavirus pandemic:

#### Building capacity

- A maximum of 25 visitors will be allowed in the entire building at any given time.
- Each gallery has a posted maximum occupancy at the entrance to the space.
- The library on the third floor is open to limited capacity of five visitors at one time.
- The lobby restroom is reserved for at-risk population and staff use only.
- The bookstore is open.

#### Cleaning procedures

- CDC and EPA approved disinfectants and cleaning supplies will be used to clean the building, with frequent sanitation of high-touch areas (railings, door handles, restrooms, elevator buttons, etc).
- A comprehensive deep-clean of the entire building is completed daily after the museum is closed to the public.

#### Events and programs:

- Teen Art Project: Community Public Art and Murals has a maximum attendance of 20 students.
- Weekly summer art camps have a maximum of twelve students per week.
- Saturday Family Workshops are cancelled until further notice.
- Members are invited to reserve free one-hour timeslots on Mondays while the museum is closed to the public. Reservations required.

**Visitors ages 5 and older are recommended to wear face coverings. Children ages 6 to 18 are required to wear face masks while inside the museum. Any MAM staff or volunteers interacting with children enrolled in a MAM program are required to wear a mask.**

Please wash hands frequently and remain 6 feet apart from other visitors with whom they are not familiar with. If you or your child are feeling sick or have a cough or fever, please do not visit MAM.

Given the changing nature of Montana's phased re-opening and the progression of the pandemic, this plan and related details are subject to change and will be revised as needed.
