



As a community organization and a communal space, we understand the vital importance of public health and protecting our visitors. The safety and health are of great concern to us and as such MAM staff have enacted the following changes to operations during the coronavirus pandemic:

Building capacity

- The library on the third floor is open.
- The lobby restroom is reserved for at-risk population and staff use only.
- The bookstore is open.

Cleaning procedures

- CDC and EPA approved disinfectants and cleaning supplies will be used to clean the building, with frequent sanitation of high-touch areas (railings, door handles, restrooms, elevator buttons, etc).
- A comprehensive deep-clean of the entire building is completed daily after the museum is closed to the public.

Events and programs

- Food and beverages will not be offered for indoor events.
- In-person programs will be held with limited capacity, to be determined by the location of the event.
- After School Art Adventure will be held with a limit of 12 students.
- At this time, there are no changes to the Fifth Grade Art Experience.
- Saturday Family Workshops are cancelled until further notice.

Visitors ages 5 and older are required to wear masks in public spaces inside the museum. Any MAM staff or volunteers interacting with children enrolled in a MAM program are required to wear a mask.

Please wash hands frequently and remain 6 feet apart from other visitors with whom they are not familiar with. If you or your child are feeling sick or have a cough or fever, please do not visit MAM.

Given the changing nature of Montana's phased re-opening and the progression of the pandemic, this plan and related details are subject to change and will be revised as needed.
